Preview on shibbolized EZproxy

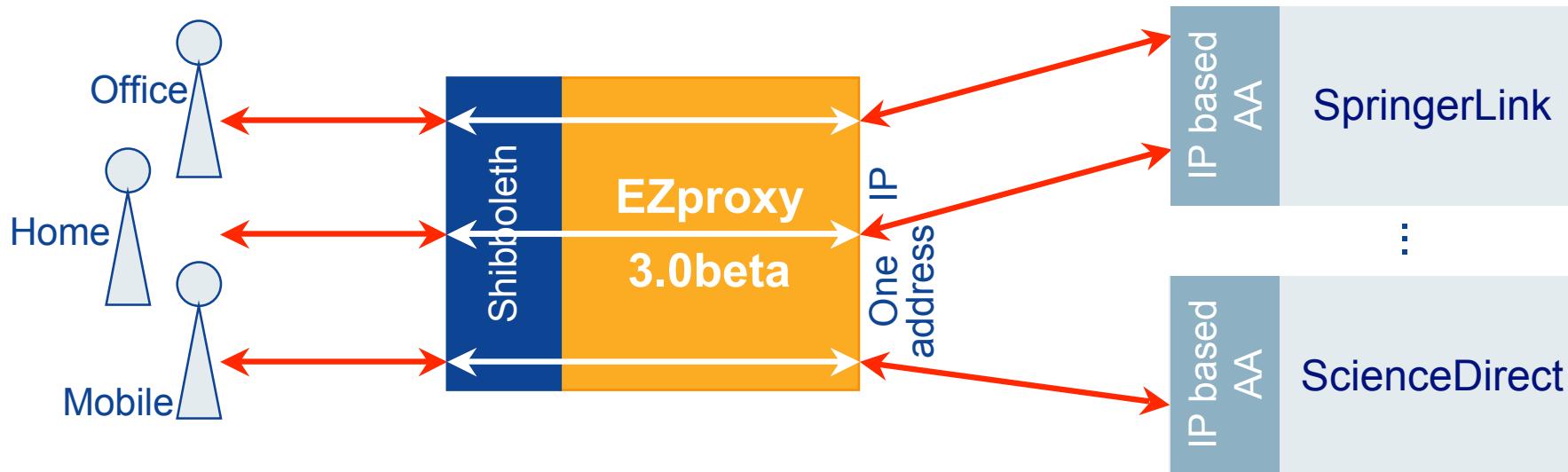
- **Concept of EZproxy**

Allow remote users access to web services with IP-based access control, primarily e-journals.

- **In use at many universities world-wide**
