

Abstract

Well co-ordinated access control is a crucial issue for the VCS project, requiring an Authentication/Authorisation Infrastructure (AAI). SWITCH proposes a one-year mandate to study and design an AAI that suits the needs of the VCS as well as further projects within universities and for collaborations with foreign institutions. The activities within the scope of this mandate will be funded by SWITCH. An AAI deployment will be proposed in follow-up mandates jointly with the universities.

1 Introduction

In the future, the VCS enables a large number of people to access a wide range of services provided by the universities over the SWITCH backbone/Internet. In any such environment, the question naturally arises how to grant access to these
