The Swiss Education & Research Network

- Next release is due May/June 2005 (using SAML 1.1)
- Backwards compatible to Shibboleth 1.1, 1.2*
- Goal: be forwards compatible to Shibboleth 2.0 (which will use SAML 2.0)
- Many improvements in general
 - Metadata modifications
 - Major changes for Identity Providers
 - Addition of a Service Provider implementation in Java (Tomcat 5.0 or 5.5)
- SWITCH will soon after the release update the deployment guides and sample configurations

- Resource Registry will be a database (June/July 2005)
 - for the scope of the SWITCHaai Federation
 - to ensure that Resource Owners are aware of the AAI Policy
 - Resource Registration Authority (per Home Org) has to accept new Resources
 - to generate configuration info required
 - More detailed info to come.

It will contain

- Info about Shibboleth protected Resources
 - →configuration info
 - required for sites.xml at Identity Providers
 - Attribute requirements of Service Providers (required and desired attributes)
 - required for data protection conformant attribute release (arp.xml)
- Info about Home Organizations
 - →configuration info
 - required for sites.xml at Service Providers


